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Need: To reduce the high infant mortality rate in Liberia


Approach: Instituting an education plan for mothers

Liberia




- o Fifth highest infant mortality rate
- o 43,000 infant deaths per year
- o 70% of births occur in rural areas
- o Little education on infant healthcare

Causes of Infant Mortality Under 5



Midwives

o 63% of births occur outside of hospitals **Health Workforce**



- o Trained midwives educate traditional midwives
- o Highly respected

- Distribute pamphlets with basic health information to midwives:
 - o Exclusive breastfeeding
 - o Symptoms of illnesses
 - o Nutrition
 - o Mother/child connection
- o Easy and economical

Plan of Action

- 1. Create pamphlets for midwives
- 2. Set up network of midwives in rural areas
- 3. UNICEF distributes pamphlets to midwives
- 4. Midwives teach mothers basic healthcare skills

Goals



- o Midwives have access to pamphlets
- o Educate mothers on infant healthcare
- o ULTIMATELY: Reduce the infant mortality rate





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
