


Panama's developing and emerging economy is threatened by economic disparity and an outdated education system.

Panama's Curricula




Panama and Costa Rica's curriculum for 3rd and 7th grade (Carnoy, Luschei, Marshall & Sorto, 2009).


TO CHANGE THE POVERTY EQUATION IN PANAMA
