Solid Waste/ Recycling Facility Process

-Recyclables to recycling market off-island.

MRF Operations:
MRF recyclables go through the sorting room where staff remove contamination, as well as open and sort the commercial haulers' bags of recyclables. The sorted material is then baled and loaded on a Cape Cod Express truck to go to recycling markets off-island.






All compost is then processed in this rotating composter. This rotating drum is equal to the length of xx and processes xx tons of compost a day.
