

Sustainability and Transportation



Why is sustainability important to WPI?

- Sustainability "creates and maintains the conditions under which humans and nature can exist in productive harmony, that permit fulfilling the social, economic and other requirements of present and future generations." (EPA)
- "WPI's campus-wide efforts in energy and resource conservation and reduction in the harmful environmental impacts of our operations, are all directed toward enhancing the long-term sustainability of WPI's activities and the environment of which we are a part." (WPI Sustainability Task Force)
- WPI has a desire to be sustainable

How is transportation related to sustainability?

- **Sustainable transportation -** any form of transportation that has a <u>low impact</u> on the environment
 - fuel-efficient public transit such as city buses and commuter rails
 - carpooling
 - non-motorized methods of transportation such as walking and cycling








The Problem

Our Research Goals


This project aims to encourage and promote alternative transportation for the WPI community.

- How safe is the area around campus for bicycling and walking? Is it reasonable to suggest promoting walking and bicycling)?







Respondents (who commute by car) who said that easier carpooling would change how they travel...









Respondents (who commute by car) who said that more frequent or convenient WRTA routes would change how they travel...




We recommend that the WRTA and WPI Department of Facilities work together to get <u>a WRTA stop on campus</u>.

Tax Deductions

We recommend that the WPI Web Development Office create a <u>clear</u>, <u>updated</u>, <u>and central website</u> with information about <u>all alternative</u> <u>transportation options</u> for WPI community members.

Mode of Alternative Transportation	"Never used it"	"Never heard of it"
WRTA Bus System	74%	4%
MBTA Commuter Rail	34%	5%
Zipcar	83%	3%
Carpool World Website	47%	52%
SNAP and Gateway Shuttles	38%	2%

Refer back to this table:

- "A few problems I have noticed with WPI transportation are that the information about routes/schedules is not well organized or widely publicized. "
- "If the options were made clearer (such as saying which bus lines go where of interest when), that might be really helpful."
- "More publicizing of the WRTA bus schedule and WPI transport options would improve alternative transportation near WPI."

Could avoid comments like:

- "Buses from MBTA in Worcester to WPI are ??? don't even know how that could be done."
- "The link from the train station to WPI seems weak or not available."
- "Perhaps transport over to Price Chopper would be useful."

Summary of Recommendations

We recommend...

- WPI's Carpool World website be improved, and that the <u>WPI Office of Student Life</u>, <u>WPI Human Resources</u>, and the <u>WPI Department of Facilities</u> promote and advertise it heavily.
- The <u>WPI Department of Facilities</u> create a free or inexpensive bike rental program, and provide more infrastructure such as air pumping stations and bike rooms around campus.
- 3. The <u>WPI Department of Facilities</u> **install a WRTA Information Ticker** and/or **WRTA kiosk** in the Rubin Campus Center.
- 4. The <u>WRTA</u> and <u>WPI Department of Facilities</u> work together to get a **WRTA stop on campus**.
- 5. <u>WPI Human Resources</u> work with the MBTA to offer a **reduced-price rate** for the **Commuter Rail**.
- 6. The <u>WPI Web Development Office</u> create a **clear, updated, and central website** with information about all alternative transportation options for WPI community members.








On/Near-Campus Respondents Who Would Change Their Habits with



On/Near-Campus Respondents Who Would Change Their Habits with a More Frequent/Convenient MBTA Commuter Rail




On-Campus: Zipcar




On/Near-Campus Respondents Who Would Change Their Habits with a Better Zipcar


