Ramadan March 10 to April 10

Ramadan is one of the holiest periods in the Islamic calendar—it's a time when Muslim students, faculty, and staff fast from dawn until dusk. For Muslims who are able, fasting means abstaining from all food and drink (yes, even water) from sunrise until sunset. It's also a time of prayer, good deeds, and reflection. After a traditional sunset prayer, those of the Muslim faith gather to break the fast with a nutritious meal called iftar, often shared with friends and family. The beginning and end of Ramadan fluctuates each year because the lunar Islamic calendar follows the moon phases and are declared by a moon sighting committee in Saudi Arabia or by specific nations' announcements. This year, Ramadan is expected to extend from sundown on March 10 and culminates in a celebration called Eid-al-Fitr on April 10.
